When I was a student at the Academie I lived in Leiden, the home town of Rembrandt. I lived in my studio with a skylight and set up my rocky kitchen table to make my first still life photos. These were mainly slides. I have pursued this type of photography until today.

This was followed by some work in a commercial studio where I first worked in digital photography using Hasselblads with digital backs. So, enough about myself, now I want to talk about you. It is your club.

## Lurie Exhibit Plans Set

**Plans for the January Lurie exhibit have been finalized.** A list of exhibitors follows this article. A total of 31 members will be exhibiting 58 prints. Most of those who signed up are first time exhibitors.

Almost everyone missed the December 15 deadline for getting information about their prints to Jo-Ann Ordano. The five who did get their information in on time are shown with asterisks after their names. Everyone else either sent in incomplete information or did not send it at all. The information for each image in the exhibit is needed by January 8th at the latest. Either send it to Jo-Ann by snail mail or hand it to her at the first meeting in January. Information received later than that date may mean an image will not be hung.

The required information includes photographer's name, title of print, type of print, sale price (if any), charity to which 10% of sale price will be donated and a brief paragraph about how, where or why the image was made.

The exhibition announcements have been printed and will be available for everyone at the January 8th meeting. At that time, all exhibitors will be asked to sign a **waiver agreement**, releasing the Lurie Company from any liability concerning prints while they are on exhibit.

Prints must be turned in at the January 15 meeting or personally delivered to the Lurie Building at 901 Market Street by 9 am on Saturday, January 24. The back of each print should have a **label** with the photographer's name, title of print and telephone number, so prints can be matched up with labels. A volunteer will be needed to collect, store and deliver prints to the Lurie Building on January 24. And several more people (one person has already offered his help) will be needed to install the exhibit.

**Then on Thursday, January 29, 5-7 pm, Atrium Gallery, 901 Market St., 2nd floor comes the gala reception. And if last January's reception is any indication, it should be a lovely affair, with wine, wonderful goodies and live music. ## Print Division Update

*Welcome* to our first full year of print competition. Based on feedback from the recent print survey, we will keep pictorial competition on the second Thursday of each month and delay adding additional categories. Beginning January 15, we will be judging slides before prints to see how this works logistically.

To help balance the competition, we are adjusting how members are assigned to competition levels. First we are eliminating the Salon level; all members who previously competed at this level will now compete at the Advanced level. Secondly, all members who have not yet competed in prints will initially be assigned to the Amateur level, regardless of their current level in slides. We will reevaluate assignments mid-year to determine if any adjustments are necessary. As of January there are a couple of promotions and demotions in Monochrome; affected members have been notified.
